



HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The High School Seniors Scholarship Program is designed to promote the Foundation's strong commitment to supporting and recognizing academic achievement among high school seniors planning to attend college. Any male high school senior entering a college with a chapter of The Delta Chi Fraternity, is eligible to apply. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded at each participating campus based on the applicant's grades, student activities, leadership experience, and community service. A secondary benefit of the program is the identification of incoming freshmen who might make excellent candidates for Delta Chi. However, there is no requirement for the student to join Delta Chi Fraternity.

CHAPTER REQUIREMENTS

All colonies are eligible to participate, as are chapters below minimum size standards. To become a participating campus, the local chapter of the Delta Chi Fraternity must submit a written request to the Delta Chi Educational Foundation by February 1 and must agree to the following:

- 1- Distribute copies of the scholarship application to high school counselors throughout the college's normal recruiting area. Applications must be distributed by March 1.
- 2- Submit a list of guidance counselor names, addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses to the Delta Chi Educational Foundation by March 15.
- 3- Establish an application review committee comprised of at least two alumni (or parents) and one undergraduate; submit their names, addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses by April 15. This committee will identify the top 10–25 applicants and submit these names to the Educational Foundation office for final selection 60 days prior to the first day of classes.
- 4- Secure and submit the name, address and phone # of the winner's hometown newspaper.
- 5- Conduct a formal presentation of the scholarship check and submit a 35 mm photograph and photo release form.
- 6- Submit a written report (review committee chair) summarizing the number of applicants received, number of candidates interviewed, general acceptance of the program, any program logistical problems identified, etc. within 30 days following the check presentation.

Chapters wishing to increase the number of scholarships may do so by contributing (directly or through alumni contributions) to the Delta Chi Educational Foundation.

- 5- Conduct a formal presentation of the scholarship check and submit a 35 mm photograph and photo release form.
- 6- Submit a written report (review committee chair) summarizing the number of applicants received, number of candidates interviewed, general acceptance of the program, any program logistical problems identified, etc. within 30 days following the check presentation.
